Benon Mutambi has worked as a University lecturer for 14 years on both a part-time and full-time basis. He has taught public sector economics, monetary economics and mathematical economics at the Faculty of Economics and Management, Makerere University. Mutambi also has nine years experience of working in the research department of the central bank and six years of experience of working in utility regulation. He currently heads the department of Economic Regulation at the Electricity Regulatory Authority of Uganda.

As a head the department of Economic Regulation department, Mutambi has been responsible for developing feed-in tariffs for small renewable projects, modelling of tariffs for generation, transmission and also end-user tariffs. At the same time, I have carried out a number of research projects in the area of utility pricing, financial sector, savings, investment and economic growth.

Mutambi has been active in the area of debt sustainability analysis, fiscal policy, monetary policy, trade policy and regional integration. In this regard, he worked as a facilitator on a number of workshops organised by MEFMI in the area of debt sustainability analysis. He was also part of the MEFMI Mission Team to Malawi in September 2003 to assist the authorities in the area of debt sustainability. He contributed greatly to the development of the training manual on domestic debt sustainability analysis.
