Eng. Julius Riungu is Chief Executive Officer of Tsavo Power Company Ltd. Julius is a Board Member of Kenya Engineers' Registration Board and a member and 1st Vice-Chairman of the Institution of Engineers of Kenya Council.

Graduating from University College, London with a degree in Electrical and Electronics Engineering in 1973, Julius worked as an Engineer for the then East African Power and Lighting Company Limited, which later became the Kenya Power and Lighting Company Ltd (KPLC). He worked in the Customer Service, Distribution and Regional Management Divisions of the Company. In 1990, he was appointed the Geothermal Development Coordinator where he was involved in the geothermal resource assessment along the Kenya's Rift Valley and drilling of production wells which now supply steam to the 70MW Olkaria II Geothermal Power Station. In 1991, Julius was promoted to Deputy Managing Director of KPLC. Julius retired from KPLC in 2005 and joined the Ministry of Energy as a Power Engineering Advisor to the Permanent Secretary. In April 2008, Julius joined Tsavo Power Company one of the largest Independent Power Producers in Kenya.

Julius is the Chairman of the Energy Sector Board of the Kenya Private Sector Alliance.
